FINAL ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' SECOND MOTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 1121(d) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE FOR AN ORDER EXTENDING THE PERIOD WITHIN WHICH THE DEBTORS HAVE THE EXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO PROPOSE A CHAPTER 11 PLAN AND SOLICIT ACCEPTANCES THEREOF

Upon the Second Motion (the "Motion")¹ of FiberTower Network Service Corp., *et al.*, the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") Pursuant to Section 1121(d) of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") for an Order Extending the Period Within Which the Debtors Have the Exclusive Right to Propose a Chapter 11 Plan and Solicit Acceptances Thereof; and the Court having jurisdiction over the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, and this being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §

157 (b)(2); and good and sufficient notice of the Motion having been given and no other or further notice of the Motion being required, and after due deliberation and good cause appearing therefor, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is granted, as set forth herein.
2. The periods within which the Debtors have the exclusive right to propose a chapter 11 plan and solicit acceptances thereof are hereby extended until August 12, 2013 and October 11, 2013, respectively.
3. This Order is without prejudice to the Debtors' rights to seek additional extensions of their exclusive periods, and the rights of other parties in interest to object thereto or to seek to shorten such periods.
