**OBJECTION OF VALLEY SERVICES, INC., DBA TRADITIONS MEAL SOLUTIONS  
TO DEBTORS' FIRST NOTICE OF PARTIALLY SATISFIED SCHEDULED CLAIMS**  
(#1122)

Valley Services, Inc., DBA Traditions Meal Solutions, (“Traditions”) files this objection to the treatment of Traditions in the Debtors’ First Notice of Partially Satisfied Scheduled Claims.

In support of its objection, Traditions states as follows:

1. Traditions is listed on Schedule A of the Notice with a claim to be allowed in the amount of \$13,558.86, as follows:

Traditions is entitled to a claim in the amount of \$37,110.86. Traditions objects to the claim being allowed in the amount of \$13,558.86, as provided in the Notice.
