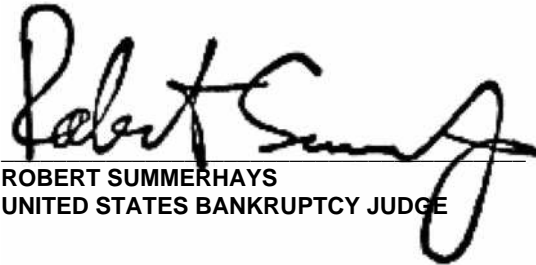

**ORDER GRANTING DOCKET NUMBERS 1411 AND 1417:
DEBTORS' MOTION TO PARTIALLY VACATE PRIOR ORDER, DECLARE ENTRY
ON CLAIM REGISTRY NULL AND VOID AND OBJECTION TO DUPLICATIVE
PROOF OF CLAIM**

Considering the *Motion to Partially Vacate Prior Order, Declare Entry On Claim Registry Null and Void, and Objection to Duplicative Proof of Claim* (this "Motion & Objection") [Docket Nos. 1411 and 1417 (these two docket entries consist of the same document

which was filed twice per the request of the clerk's office)], filed on behalf of Debtors and Debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"),² and upon the record of these chapter 11 cases and due deliberation thereon, and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

And considering that the Motion & Objection was noticed for hearing on an if and only if basis, requiring a creditor to file a response by March 11, 2014, in order to trigger a hearing on any such response on March 18, 2014 [Docket No. 1419],

And considering that no creditor filed a response on or before March 11, 2014, to the Objection,

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED and the Objection is SUSTAINED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Claim No. 67 is disallowed and expunged; and

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED that Claim No. 67 is the result of a data entry error, and therefore, that it is null and void in its entirety; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk make a notation on the claims register indicating this revised status of Claim No. 67; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court's Order Granting Debtors' First Omnibus Objection To Duplicate Claims [Dkt. No. 1033], is vacated, but only insofar as that Order concerns Claim No. 66; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or relating to the interpretation or implementation of this Order.

The entity submitting this Motion & Objection represents to the Court that the underlying Motion & Objection was filed and served in conformity with the local rules that no pleading or response has been filed in opposition thereto, and that the relief to be granted by this Order is
