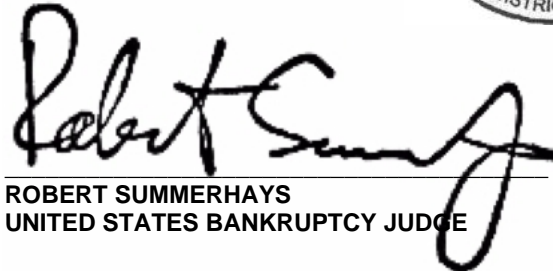

**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION TO (1) COMPROMISE WORKERS'  
COMPENSATION CLAIM UNDER RULE 9019, AND (2) PAY THE SAME**

Considering the *Motion for Authority to (1) Compromise Workers' Compensation Claim Under Rule 9019, and (2) Pay the Same* (the "Motion") (Docket #530) filed herein on March 3, 2013, by the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"),<sup>2</sup>

by the Debtors, the Court concluding that (a) it has jurisdiction over this Motion, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, and that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (b) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates and creditors, (c) sufficient notice was given herein; (d) no pleading or response having been filed in opposition to the Motion, and the relief to be granted in this Order is consistent with the relief pled for in the Motion;

**IT IS ORDERED** that the Motion is hereby **GRANTED**;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Debtors seek further authority to pay the settled claim, in accordance with the Order Approving Workers' Compensation Settlement, dated March 4, 2013, that is part of **Exhibit A** to the Motion; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Debtors are authorized to execute and deliver all instruments and documents, and take such other actions as may be necessary or appropriate to implement and effectuate this Order.
