**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION TO (1) COMPROMISE WORKERS'
COMPENSATION CLAIM UNDER RULE 9019, AND (2) PAY THE SAME**

Considering the *Motion for Authority to (1) Compromise Workers' Compensation Claim Under Rule 9019, and (2) Pay the Same* (the "Motion") (Docket #530) filed herein on March 3, 2013, by the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"),²

by the Debtors, the Court concluding that (a) it has jurisdiction over this Motion, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, and that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (b) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates and creditors, (c) sufficient notice was given herein; (d) no pleading or response having been filed in opposition to the Motion, and the relief to be granted in this Order is consistent with the relief pled for in the Motion;

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is hereby **GRANTED**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors seek further authority to pay the settled claim, in accordance with the Order Approving Workers' Compensation Settlement, dated March 4, 2013, that is part of **Exhibit A** to the Motion; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized to execute and deliver all instruments and documents, and take such other actions as may be necessary or appropriate to implement and effectuate this Order.


