1. On December 3, 2013, the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") filed the Application of Debtors and Debtors in Possession

Pursuant to Sections 327(a) and 330(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a) and

Local Bankruptcy Rule 2014-1 for an Order Authorizing Them to Retain and Employ Deloitte

Financial Advisory Services LLP as Financial Advisor Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date

[Docket No. 127] (the "Application"). On January 17, 2014, the Debtor filed a supplemental declaration made by Mr. Boucher in support of the Application [Docket No. 247]. - 3. Following the filing of the Objection, the Debtors, the U.S. Trustee and Deloitte Financial Advisory Services LLP entered into negotiations regarding the Application and the Objection.
