THIS CAUSE came before the Court on November 18, 2014 on the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors’ Motion for Continuance of Hearing of Debtors’ Motion for Final Order Under Sections 105, 361, 362, 363, 364 and 507 of the Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002, 4001 and 9014 (i) Authorizing the Debtors to Incur Post-Petition Senior Secured Superpriority Indebtedness; (ii) Authorizing Use of Cash Collateral; (iii) Granting Post-Petition Priming and Senior Priority Security Interest and Superpriority Claims; (iv) Granting Adequate Protection and (v) Modifying the Automatic Stay (“Motion for Continuance”) (Dkt.
