## ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO EMPLOY AND RETAIN SANDLER O'NEILL & PARTNERS, L.P. AS INVESTMENT BANKER [Dkt. # 232]

This matter came before the Court on the *Application of Debtors for Authority to Employ Sandler O'Neill & Partners, L.P. as Investment Banker* (the "*Application*")<sup>2</sup> [Dkt. # 232] filed herein by Mississippi Phosphates Corporation, *et al.* the Debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "*Debtors*"). The Court considered the Application and the premises, and finds
