NOTICE OF HEARING AND DEADLINES

Rob Lunsford, on behalf of Gregory McCloud, has filed a MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY IMPOSED BY 11 U.S.C. SECTION 362 (the "Motion") (Dkt. # 381) with the Court in the above-styled case.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you might wish to consult one.)

The Court will hold a combined and final hearing on February 12, 2015, at 01:30 PM in the Bankruptcy Courtroom, 7th Floor, Dan M. Russell, Jr. U.S. Courthouse, 2012 15th Street, Gulfport, Mississippi, to consider and act upon the Motion.

If you do not want the Court to grant the Motion, or if you want the Court to consider your views on the Motion, you or your attorney must file a written response explaining your position so that the Court receives it on or before February 5, 2015. Attorneys and Registered Users of the Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system should file any response using ECF. Others should file any response at U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Dan M. Russell, Jr. U.S. Courthouse, 2012 15th Street, Suite 244, Gulfport, MS, 39501. If you file a response, you or your attorney are required to attend the hearing. The hearing will be electronically recorded by the Court.

If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the Motion. If no response is filed, the Court may consider the Motion and enter an order granting relief before the hearing date.
