**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that Mississippi Phosphates Corporation, *et al.*, the Debtors and debtors-in-possession herein (“*Debtors*”), in these Bankruptcy Cases, have filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court the *Application of the Debtors to Retain Deloitte Transactions and Business Analytics LLP to Provide the Debtors with “Other Services” Nunc Pro Tunc to December 20, 2014* (the “*Application*”) [Dkt. # 441].
