AGREED ORDER GRANTING FIFTH INTERIM APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES SUBMITTED BY BURR & FORMAN LLP, ATTORNEYS FOR THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS

This matter came before the Court on the Fifth Interim Application for Compensation and

Reimbursement of Expenses Submitted by Burr & Forman LLP, Attorneys for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (Dkt. No. 1138) (the "Application") seeking allowance of compensation in the amount of \$85,969.50 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$58.77 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331, Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Local Bankruptcy Rules of this Court, and the Order Granting Motion of the Debtor for an Administrative Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 331 and 503 to Establish a

Procedure for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Employed Professionals of the Debtors and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (Dkt. No. 586) (the "Interim Compensation Order"). The Court has considered the Application and the entire record herein, finds that notice of the Application was properly given to all required creditors and parties in interest and that no objections or other responses were timely filed to the Application. The Court further finds that the Application should be granted as set forth herein, and it is **SO ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Application is approved.

2. Burr & Forman LLP is awarded interim fees as an administrative expense claim in the amount of \$85,969.50 for legal services rendered to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors which is 100 percent of the fees requested in the Application.

3. Burr & Forman LLP is awarded interim costs and expenses in the amount of \$58.77 which is 100 percent of the fees requested in the Application.

4. The amounts set forth herein shall be paid forthwith on an interim basis but only to the extent that there are unencumbered funds of the Debtor available.

5. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
