**ORDER SUSTAINING OBJECTIONS OF
MISSISSIPPI PHOSPHATES CORPORATION TO CERTAIN CLAIMS
CONTAINED IN OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CERTAIN LATE-FILED CLAIMS**

[Dkt. # 1456]

This matter came for consideration before the Court on the *First Omnibus Objection of Mississippi Phosphates Corporation Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502, Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007 and 9014 and Miss. Bankr. L.R. 3007-1 to Certain Late-Filed Claims* [Dkt. # 1453] (the “**Objection**”)² filed by Mississippi Phosphates Corporation, the Debtor and Debtor-in-possession herein (the “**Debtor**”) to certain Proofs of Claim (each a “**Claim**” and collectively, the “**Claims**”)

filed by certain persons listed below (each a “*Claimant*” and collectively, the “*Claimants*”) on the basis that each such Claim was a late-filed claim (each, a “*Claim Objection*” and collectively, the “*Claims Objections*”).³

The Court finds as follows:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over this Fee Application pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. This is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A) & (B).

2. The bases for the relief sought by the Debtor in the Claims Objections is pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 101 et seq. (the “*Bankruptcy Code*”), and specifically 11 U.S.C. §§ 102, 105, and 502, Rule 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “*Bankruptcy Rules*”), and Miss. Bankr. L.R. 3007-1.

3. As reflected by the applicable Certificates of Service, a true and correct copy of a *Notice of Objection to Claim*, together with a copy of the respective *Objection to Claim* was served on each Claimant by United States Mail, postage prepaid, to the address on the Proof of Claim form filed by each Claimant.

4. No objections or other responses were timely filed with respect to the Objections to the Claims set forth on Exhibit A hereto (the “*Uncontested Claims Objections*”).

5. Because MPC, as the debtor-in-possession, has objected to the Claims, the Claims of the Claimants listed on Exhibit A hereto are no longer deemed allowed, pursuant to Section 502(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

³ Pursuant to the Court’s *Order Authorizing Debtors to Employ and Retain BMC Group, Inc. as Noticing and Claims Agent* [Dkt. # 257], the Debtors retained BMC Group, Inc. (“*BMC*”) as the claims and noticing agent. Accordingly, BMC maintained the official claims register on behalf of the Clerk and BMC also assigned its own BMC claim number for each Claim.

6. Because each Claimant listed on Exhibit A hereto has failed to respond to the Claim Objection with respect to the applicable Claim, the Claims of each of the Claimants listed on Exhibit A hereto should be disallowed as a Late-Filed Claim, and the Uncontested Claims Objections should be sustained.

7. Pursuant to Section 502(b)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Claim of each Claimant listed on Exhibit A hereto should be disallowed as a Late-Filed Claim and expunged for all purposes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Objections of the Debtor with respect to each of the Claims of each of the Claimants listed on Exhibit A hereto is well-taken and should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Claims of each of the Claimants listed on Exhibit A hereto shall be disallowed as a Late-Filed Claim and expunged for all purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to any matters, claims, rights or disputes arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
