CUSTOMER NOTICE OF BANKRUPTCY

The debtor hereby gives each person and entity named in the Known Customer Service List filed with the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court under seal, notice that:

A. Case Commencement; Court and Address. The Debtor filed a Voluntary Petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire, 1000 Elm Street, Manchester, New Hampshire 03101.

B. Creditors Must File Proofs of Claim; Claim Bar Date. All creditors must file Proof of Claim in the form appearing on the other side of this Notice with the Clerk of the Court so that the Clerk receives the Proof on or before 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on **June 1, 2015** (the "**Claim Bar Date**"). Instructions for completing the Proof of Claim may be found at <http://www.nhb.uscourts.gov/OrdersRulesForms/forms/proofofclaim.pdf>.

C. Priority Consumer Deposit Claim. You may have a priority deposit claim to the extent of \$2,775 arising from the deposit, before the commencement of the case, of money in connection with the purchase of property or services from the debtor for your personal, family, or household use that were not delivered or provided.

D. Certain Warnings. Creditors who do not file a Proof of Claim by the Claim Bar Date will not be paid a dividend in this Case. You should attach the documents supporting your claim. If you have any doubt regarding your status, you must complete Section 5 of the Proof of Claim titled "Amount of Claim Entitled to Priority" or your claim may be treated as an unsecured claim without priority. If the Debtor objects to your Proof of Claim, a copy of the Objection will be mailed to you.

E. No Further Notice Possible. The United States Trustee has appointed an Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "**Committee**"). The Debtor intends to request the Court to limit notice to the Chairman of the Committee and its counsel. If any creditor wishes to be given notice of all pleadings filed and hearings to be held in the Case, the creditor must file a Notice of Appearance and demand copies of all pleadings filed and hearings to be held in the Case.
