**ORDER GRANTING FIFTH AND FINAL APPLICATION OF
HILDER & ASSOCIATES, P.C., SPECIAL LITIGATION COUNSEL TO THE
DEBTORS, FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED**

Upon consideration of the *Fifth and Final Application of Hilder & Associates, P.C., Special Litigation Counsel to the Debtors, for Allowance of Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred for the Period August 26, 2016, through December 8, 2017* (the "Application"), the Court hereby finds that:

- A. The Court has jurisdiction over this Application under 28 U.S.C. § 1334.
- B. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b).
- C. Venue is proper in this district under 28 U.S.C. § 1408.
- D. Due notice and opportunity to be heard were given respecting the Application.
- E. Good and sufficient cause exists for granting the relief requested in the Application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Court approves and allows on a final basis \$112,949.50 in fees and \$1,975.82 in expenses for services performed and expenses incurred by Hilder & Associates, P.C. ("Hilder") during the Application Period (as defined in the Application).
2. The Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Hilder all fees and expenses allowed pursuant to this Order within 14 days of the entry of this Order, if not already paid.
3. Nothing in this Order bars Hilder from filing a supplement to this Application.
4. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation and enforcement of this Order.
