**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION TO APPOINT BMC GROUP, INC. AS  
NOTICING AGENT OF THE COURT PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 156(c)**

The Court has considered the *Application to Appoint BMC Group, Inc. as Noticing Agent of the Court Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 156(c)* (the “Application”) filed by ABC Dentistry, P.A., et al. (the “Debtors”). The Court, after considering the Application, and any responses thereto, finds that BMC Group, Inc. (“BMC”) is a disinterested person under the meaning of 11 U.S.C. §101(14) and that their engagement is beneficial to the estate and necessary. Moreover, delay in the engagement would cause harm to the Debtors and creditors, so any restriction of FED. R. BANKR. P. 6003 is met and it is therefore:

ORDERED that the Debtors’ employment of BMC as Noticing Agent<sup>2</sup> is hereby APPROVED.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that retention of BMC by the Debtors under the terms of the Agreement attached to the Application is APPROVED.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the fees and expenses of BMC incurred in the performance of the services rendered in this case are to be treated as an administrative expense of the Debtors’ Chapter 11 estate, and shall be paid by the Debtors in the ordinary course of

business after the submission of an invoice in reasonable detail describing the basis for the fees and expenses requested to be paid thereto and upon approval of said invoice by the Debtors.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that BMC shall, on a monthly basis, submit copies of the invoices it submits to the Debtors for services rendered and for reimbursement of expenses to the Office of the United States Trustee, and counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, if any.
