Traylor, and the affidavit of Payroll Outsourcing Plus, Inc. (the "Affidavits"), which are annexed to the Application; and the Court being satisfied based on the representations made in the Application and the Affidavits that (i) except as disclosed in the Affidavits and the exhibits attached thereto, KPMG LLP represents no interest adverse to the Debtors' estates or creditors with respect to the matters upon which KPMG LLP is to be engaged, and (ii) the employment of KPMG LLP is necessary and in the best interests of the Committee and the Debtors' estates; and it appearing that due and proper notice of the Application having been provided; and after due deliberation, and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Application is granted in its entirety; and it is further SSL-DOCS1 1478415v2

ORDERED, that the Committee's retention of KPMG LLP as its financial advisors, <u>nunc pro tunc</u> to June 25, 2004, is hereby approved according to the terms set forth in the Application; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Committee is authorized to retain and employ Bill A. Traylor, an industry specialist, to assist KPMG LLP in providing services to the Committee, and that Bill A. Traylor will be employed and compensated by Payroll Outsourcing Plus, Inc., pursuant to the terms set forth in the Application; and it is further

ORDERED, that KPMG LLP shall be compensated in accordance with Sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and such Bankruptcy Rules as may be then applicable, as well as any procedures fixed by order of this Court.
