Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Plan and the Disclosure Statement. The attached Master Ballot is being sent to brokers, proxy intermediaries and other nominees (the "Nominees") of the persons and entities (the "Beneficial Holders") holding beneficial interests in the Class 6 General Unsecured Claims as of the Voting Record Date. This Master Ballot may not be used for any purpose other than for transmitting votes of your Beneficial Holders to accept or reject the Plan and certifying as to actions taken with respect thereto.

1. Class 6 General Unsecured Claims shall have accepted the Plan if (a) the holders (other than any holder designated under section 1126(e) of the Bankruptcy Code) of at least two-thirds in amount of the Allowed Claims actually voting in such Class have voted to accept the Plan and (b) the holders (other than any holder designated under section 1126(e) of the Bankruptcy Code) of more than one-half in number of the Allowed Claims actually voting in such Class have voted to accept the Plan. The Reorganizing Debtors reserve the right, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Plan, to seek confirmation of the Plan pursuant to section 1129(b) of the Bankruptcy Code. Please review the Disclosure Statement for more information.

2. You should deliver the Ballots and other documents relating to the Plan, including the Disclosure Statement (collectively, the "<u>Solicitation Materials</u>"), to each Beneficial Holder of Class 6 Claims with respect to Senior Unsecured Notes held through you and take any action required to enable each such Beneficial Holder to vote Class 6 Claims with respect to Senior Unsecured Notes held by such Beneficial Holder. With regard to any Ballots returned to you, to have the vote of your Beneficial Holders count, you must, by the Voting Deadline, unless the Reorganizing Debtors extend or waive such Voting Deadline: (a) transfer the requested information from each such Ballot onto the attached Master Ballot, (b) execute the Master Ballot and (c) deliver such Master Ballot to the Voting Deadline (or such other date as is set by subsequent Bankruptcy Court order). 3. If this Master Ballot is received after the Voting Deadline, the votes of your Beneficial Holders may not be counted. The method of delivery of a Master Ballot to be sent to the Voting Agent is at the election and risk of the entity submitting it. Please note that Item 2 requests information for each Beneficial Holder for whom you are voting a Class 6 Claim with respect to Senior Unsecured Notes (to identify such Beneficial Holders, please use the account number assigned by you for each such Beneficial Holder).
