**BRIDGE ORDER ON EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ENTRY OF BRIDGE ORDER
EXTENDING CLAIMS OBJECTION DEADLINE FOR CHICAGO EXPRESS
AIRLINES, INC. N/K/A C8 AIRLINES, INC. AND FINAL ORDER EXTENDING
CLAIMS OBJECTION DEADLINE THROUGH DECEMBER 9, 2006**

This matter is before the Court upon the Emergency Motion For Entry Of Bridge Order Extending Claims Objection Deadline For Chicago Express Airlines, Inc. n/k/a C8 Airlines, Inc. And Final Order Extending Claims Objection Deadline Through December 9, 2006 (the "Motion")². The Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §

157(b)(2); (iii) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estates and its creditors; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Motion has been given and that no further notice is necessary; and (v) good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief requested in the Motion after having given due deliberation upon the Motion, and all of the proceedings had before the Court in connection with the Motion. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Claims Objection Deadline is extended through the later of: (i) October 24, 2006; and (ii) the date of entry of an order on the Debtor's request in the Motion for entry of the Final Order.

2. If any objections to the Motion are filed on or before October 23, 2006, the Court will consider the Debtor's request for entry of the Final Order and objections thereto at a telephonic hearing on October 24, 2006.
