**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' FIRST OBJECTION TO CERTAIN CLAIMS
RELATING TO THE REJECTION OF AIRCRAFT AND ENGINE LEASES WITH
RESPECT TO CLAIMS FILED BY JOHN HANCOCK LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY**
