**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' SECOND OBJECTION TO CERTAIN CLAIMS
RELATING TO THE REJECTION OF AIRCRAFT AND ENGINE LEASES WITH
RESPECT TO CLAIMS FILED BY US BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION**

This matter is before the Court on the Debtors' Second Objection to Certain Aircraft Claims Relating to the Rejection of Aircraft and Engine Leases filed by the Debtors¹ on October 18, 2005 (Docket No. 3082) (the "Second Omnibus Objection).
