This matter is scheduled for further preliminary injunction hearing (the "Preliminary Injunction Hearing") on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2007 following the omnibus hearing at 9:30 a.m. EST, <u>unless</u> the City files a motion requesting an emergency hearing prior to the Status Hearing and setting forth its reasons for same, in which case, the Preliminary Injunction Hearing will instead be heard on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. EST in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Indiana, Room 107, 121 W. Spring Street, New Albany, Indiana.
