This matter is before the Court on the Third Stipulation and Request for Extension of the Interim Order Regarding Cash Collateral Use (the "Stipulation") filed by the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors") and the ATSB Lenders on November 23, 2004. Debtors and the ATSB Lenders filed the Stipulation evidencing their agreement to jointly request that the Court enter an order extending the period during which Debtors may use the ATSB Lenders' cash collateral and other collateral subject to the Interim
