ORDER ON EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ENTRY OF BRIDGE ORDER GRANTING CERTAIN INTERIM RELIEF PENDING FINAL HEARING

Upon the First Day Motion For An Order Pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 364(c)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing the Debtor to (I) Maintain and Use Existing Bank Accounts and Business Forms And (II) Maintain and Use Existing Cash Management System (the "Cash Management Motion") and the Emergency Motion For Entry Of Bridge Order Granting Certain Interim Relief Pending Final Hearing (the "Bridge Order Motion") filed by the debtor in the above-captioned chapter 11 case (the "Debtor") and it appearing that granting this interim relief requested with notice under S.D. Ind. B 9013-3 and hearing on a final order on an expedited basis is in the best interests of the Debtor's estate, its creditors and other parties in interest; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C.

§ 158(a); and after due deliberation and cause appearing, the Court FINDS that the facts set forth in the Motion support the relief requested, and therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

- The Motion is GRANTED in the interim pending a determination by the
 Court on the Cash Management Motion at the Hearing on First Day Motions.
- 2. In this interim period, the Debtor is authorized to incur charges on the P-Cards and, in the reasonable exercise of their business judgment, to allow employees to use the P-Cards as that term is defined in the Bridge Order Motion and the Cash Management Motion for the purposes listed in the Bridge Order Motion or other such emergency uses as the Debtor may deem necessary.
- 3. In this interim period, National City Bank, N.A. ("<u>National City</u>") is hereby authorized and directed to continue to service and administer the P-Cards and honor any charges incurred on the P-Cards without interruption and in the usual and ordinary course in accordance with the agreement governing the P-Cards.
- 4. In the event the Debtor defaults on its obligation to repay any charges incurred on the P-Cards during this interim period, the automatic stay under 11 U.S.C. § 362 is hereby modified to the extent necessary to permit National City to enforce it rights under the Purchase Card Agreement (as defined in the Cash Management Motion) to offset the amounts charged on the P-Cards during the interim period against the P-Card Cash Collateral.
- 5. The Cash Management Motion shall be heard at the First Day Hearing set in this Chapter 11 Case, at which time the Court will consider continuation of this Bridge Order and or entry of a final order on the Cash Management Motion.
- 6. Nothing contained in this Bridge Order or the Bridge Order Motion shall constitute a rejection or assumption by the Debtor, as debtor-in-possession, of any executory

contract or unexpired lease by virtue of reference of any such contract or lease in the Bridge Order Motion.
