INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROOF OF CLAIM FORM

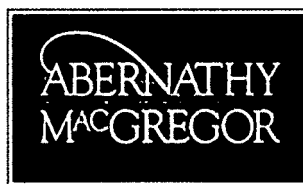

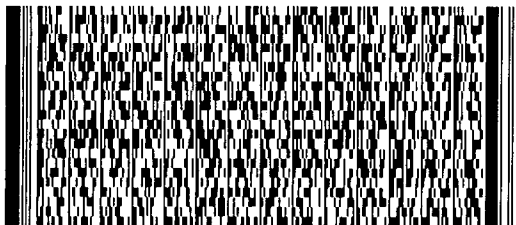

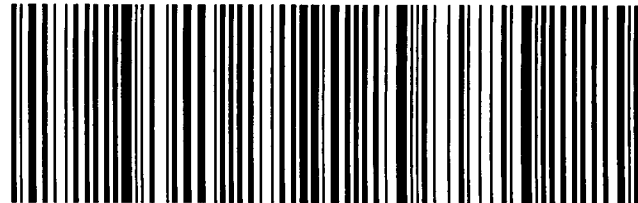
