SECOND MONTHLY APPLICATION OF PLANTE & MORAN, PLLC FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES AS TAX SERVICES PROVIDER TO THE DEBTORS AND DEBTORS-IN-POSSESSION FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANURARY 1, 2014 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2014

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331 and Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Plante & Moran, PLLC (hereinafter "Plante & Moran" or the "Firm") hereby moves this Court for reasonable compensation for professional legal services rendered as tax services provider to the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively the "Debtors") in the amount of \$35,606.25, together with reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the amount of \$15.90 for the period commencing January 1, 2014 through and including March 31, 2014(the "Fee Period"). In support of its Application, Plante & Moran respectfully represents as follows:

1. Plante & Moran was employed as tax services provider *nunc pro tunc* to September 10, 2013 to the Debtors in connection with these chapter 11 cases, pursuant to an

Order entered by this Court on October 15, 2013. The Order authorized Firm to be compensated on an hourly basis and to be reimbursed for actual and necessary out-of-pocket expenses.

2. All services for which compensation is requested by Plante & Moran were performed for or on behalf of the Debtors.

#### SUMMARY OF SERVICES RENDERED

- 3. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a detailed statement of fees incurred during the Fee Period for Plante & Moran showing the amount of \$35,606.25 due for fees.

  Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a detailed statement of expenses paid during the Fee Period for Plante & Moran showing the amount of \$15.90 for reimbursement of expenses.
- 4. The services rendered by Plante & Moran during the Fee Period are grouped into the categories set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u>. The professionals who rendered services relating to each category are identified, along with the number of hours for each individual and the total compensation sought for each category, in the attachments hereto.

#### **DISBURSEMENTS**

5. Plante & Moran has incurred out-of-pocket disbursements during the Fee Period in the amount of \$15.90. This disbursement sum is broken down into categories of charges, including, among other things, certified mailing postage and FedEx shipping. A complete review by category of the expenses incurred for the Fee Period may be found in the attachments hereto as <a href="Exhibit B">Exhibit B</a>. To the extent such itemization is insufficient to satisfy the requirements of Del. Bankr. LR 2016-2(e)(ii), Plante & Moran respectfully requests that the Court waive strict compliance with such rule.

### **VALUATION OF SERVICES**

- 7. Professionals of Plante & Moran have expended a total of 115.70 hours for this matter during the Fee Period.
- 8. The amount of time spent by each of these persons providing services to the Debtors for the Fee Period is fully set forth in the detail attached hereto as Exhibit A. These are Plante & Moran's normal hourly rates of compensation for work of this character. The reasonable value of the services rendered by Plante & Moran for the Period as tax services provider to the Debtors in these cases under Chapter 11 is \$35,606.25.
- 9. Plante & Moran believes that the time entries included in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and the expense breakdown set forth in <u>Exhibit B</u> hereto are in compliance with the requirements of Local Rule 2016-2.
- 10. In accordance with the factors enumerated in 11 U.S.C. §330, the amount requested is fair and reasonable given (a) the complexity of this case, (b) the time expended, (c) the nature and extent of the services rendered, (d) the value of such services, and (e) the costs of comparable services other than in a case under this title.
- 11. This Application covers the period January 1, 2014 through and including March 31, 2014. Plante & Moran has and will continue to perform additional necessary services subsequent to March 31, 2014, for which Plante & Moran will file subsequent fee applications.

WHEREFORE, Plante & Moran requests that allowance be made to it in the sum of \$35,606.25 as compensation for necessary professional services rendered to the Debtors for the Fee Period, and that the sum of \$15.90 for reimbursement of actual and necessary costs incurred during the Fee Period, and further requests such other and further relief as this Court may deem just and proper.
