**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF TINAMARIE FEIL  
IN SUPPORT OF THE DEBTOR’S APPLICATION FOR AN  
ORDER APPOINTING BMC GROUP, INC. AS ADMINISTRATIVE  
AGENT FOR THE DEBTOR, NUNC PRO TUNC TO AUGUST 11, 2016**

I, Tinamarie Feil, under penalty of perjury, declare as follows:

1. I am President of Client Services at BMC Group, Inc. (“BMC”), an information management services firm, with regional offices located at 259 West 30<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 401, New York, New York 10001.

2. I submit this declaration as a supplement (the “Supplemental Declaration”) to my prior Declaration (the “Original BMC Declaration”) filed as Exhibit A in support of the *Debtor’s Application for an Order Appointing BMC Group, Inc. as Administrative Agent for the Debtor, Nunc Pro Tunc to August 11, 2016* [ECF No. 186]. Except as otherwise noted, I have personal knowledge of the facts contained in this Supplemental Declaration.

3. Upon the Debtor’s request, BMC has performed or will continue to perform the following administrative services (the “Administrative Services”) to the Debtor and its estate:

- a. assist with, among other things, plan solicitation, balloting, tabulation of votes, preparation of reports and official ballot certification, as required in support of confirmation of the Debtor’s chapter 11 plan, and, if necessary, testify in support of the ballot tabulation results;
- b. provide data analysis and prepare any reports, exhibits and/or schedules of information requested in support of the Debtor’s plan confirmation and preparations to take the Debtor’s confirmed plan effective; and
- c. provide assistance to the Debtor and its counsel and financial advisor with respect to any claims objections, exhibits, claims reconciliation and related matters.

4. BMC has agreed to charge hourly rates ranging from \$85 to \$175 depending on the level of personnel performing Administrative Services. BMC further agreed that such rates would remain fixed without increase during its engagement by the Debtor.

5. I have reviewed the Debtor’s Schedules of Assets and Liabilities [ECF No. 37] and Statement of Financial Affairs [ECF No. 38] and determined that BMC has no connections to the Debtor, its creditors, equity interest holders, respective attorneys or accountants. Further, BMC has no connections to any United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of

New York, the United States Trustee for Region 2, or any person employed by that office of the United States Trustee. This paragraph is intended to replace and supersede the entirety of paragraph 5 of my Original BMC Declaration.

6. Paragraph 7 of my Original BMC Declaration stated that the Debtor owed BMC \$10,807.02 in connection with services rendered by BMC as the Debtor's Claims & Noticing Agent. Currently, there are no outstanding sums owed by the Debtor to BMC.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my information, knowledge and belief.
