**ORDER GRANTING THE DEBTOR'S

Upon the objection (the "Objection"),¹ of Airfasttickets, Inc., the debtor and debtor in possession (the "Debtor"), seeking entry of an order reducing, expunging, and/or disallowing the proof of claim (Claim No. 80) (the "Koklonis Claim") filed by Nikolaos Koklonis ("Koklonis") under 11 U.S.C. §§ 501, 502(b), 502(d), 510(c), 1106(a) and 1107(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, as

supplemented by Rule 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and the Court having jurisdiction over the Objection pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Objection and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408; and due and proper notice of the Objection having been provided and it appearing no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having determined that the relief sought in the Objection is in the best interest of the bankruptcy estate and the Debtor's creditors; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that, the Objection is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that, the Koklonis Claim (Claim No. 80) is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety from the claims registry; and it is further

ORDERED that, this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to this Order.
