KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Brian S Becker, a Vice President of Hartford Fire Insurance Company and its insurance company affiliates (collectively, "Hartford"), does hereby make, constitute and appoint Hank D Hoffman of Hartford County, Connecticut his true and lawful Attorney-in-fact, with full power and authority to said Attorney-in-fact to sign, execute and acknowledge any and all pleadings, releases settlement agreements, proofs of claims and other legal writings obligatory in the nature thereof on his behalf, not to exceed \$250,000 00, in Hartford's agency accounting, premium and bond collections and subrogation efforts and to bind Hartford thereby as fully and to the same extent as if such writings were signed by a Vice President, and hereby ratifies and confirms all that his said Attorney-in-fact may do in pursuance hereof
