ADDENDUM TO THE CONFERENCE OF EASTERN WAYNE'S PROOF OF CLAIM

The Conference of Eastern Wayne (Wayne County, Michigan), which acts as the Emergency Telephone District Board for the Conference of Eastern Wayne 911 Service District ("CEW"), is a public body corporate and politic, and was established pursuant to Michigan Compiled Laws Act 7, Public Acts of 1967, Extra Session, as amended. CEW is a consortium of six Wayne County, Michigan villages and cities (Grosse Pointe Woods, Grosse Pointe Farms, the City of Grosse Pointe, Grosse Pointe Park, Grosse Pointe Shores, and Harper Woods). Among the CEW's activities is the provision of 911 telephone service for the CEW member communities (the "CEW area"). Under Michigan law, telephone service providers are required to bill and collect a 911 operational charge that is payable to the local entities that provide the 911 service - in this case, CEW. The basis for CEW's claim relates to collection and payment of these operational charges from ALLEGIANCE TELECOM, INC, *et al* (the "Debtor").

The relationship between CEW and the Debtor is controlled by Michigan statute (M C L 484 2102, *et seq*). Pursuant to the referenced statute, the Debtor (or any other telephone service provider that operates in the CEW area) is required to collect a 911 surcharge from its customers in the CEW area and to remit such surcharge to CEW. The relationship between CEW and the Debtor is entirely governed by Michigan state law.

The Debtor may be in default with respect to its obligations to remit 911 surcharges to CEW. The Debtor continues to be responsible for complying with its obligations under Michigan law during the course of these proceedings. CEW is not presently able to ascertain the amount of any arrearages owed to CEW by the Debtor. Accordingly, CEW has represented its claim as being unliquidated. However, CEW reserves the right to amend this proof of claim at a later date upon the discovery of new or additional information related to its claim.


