

Pursuant to that certain Credit and Guaranty Agreement dated as of February 15, 2000 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time the “Prepetition Credit Agreement”) and the related loan documents thereto (the “Prepetition Loan Documents”) between and among Allegiance Telecom Company WorldWide (“Allegiance”), the Debtors, lenders party thereto from time to time, Goldman Sachs Credit Partners L P , as syndication agent, General Electric Capital Corporation (as

successor in interest to Toronto Dominion (Texas), Inc ), as administrative agent (the “Agent”), and BankBoston, N A and Morgan Stanley Senior Funding, Inc , as co-documentation agents, Allegiance and the Debtors incurred the Obligations under the Prepetition Credit Agreement Capitalized terms not defined herein have the meanings ascribed to them under the Prepetition Credit Agreement

As of the petition date, on May 14, 2003, the principal amount<sup>1</sup> of the outstanding and accrued Obligations and interest<sup>2</sup> under the Prepetition Credit Agreement were as follows
