Mary C. Albert, being duly sworn, upon her oath, deposes and says:

1. I am an attorney licensed to practice in the District of Columbia located at 3110 38th Street N.W., Washington, D.C. I am familiar with the clients I represent.
2. On May 14, 2003, Allegiance Telecom, Inc. and its direct and indirect subsidiaries (collectively, the "Debtors") commenced voluntary cases under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") with this Court (the "Chapter 11 Cases"). The Debtors requested and this Court ordered the joint administration of the Chapter 11 Cases pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1015(b).
3. The Debtors have requested that I provide legal services to the Debtors, and I have consented to provide such legal services pursuant to the requirements of this Court's Interim Order Pursuant to Sections 105(a), 327, 328, 330 and 363(c) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing Employment of Professionals Utilized in the Ordinary Course of Business, dated May 15, 2003 (the "Order").
4. This Affidavit is being submitted in support of my retention to provide legal services and in accordance with the requirements of the Order and General Order M-242 of this Court.
5. Except as otherwise indicated and except for facts that are matters of public record, all facts set forth in this Affidavit are based on my personal knowledge.
6. I may have performed services in the past and may perform services in the future, in matters unrelated to these chapter 11 cases, for persons that are parties in interest in the Chapter 11 Cases. As part of my customary practice, I am retained in cases, proceedings, and transactions involving many different parties, some of whom may represent or be claimants, employees of the Debtors, or other parties in interest in the Chapter 11 Cases. I do not perform services for any such person in connection with the Chapter 11 Cases. In addition, I do not have

any relationship with any such person, their attorneys, or accountants that would be adverse to the Debtors or their estates.

7. I have not agreed to share nor or will I share any portion of the compensation to be received from the Debtors with any other person.

8. Insofar as I have been able to ascertain, I do not represent or hold any interest adverse to the Debtors or their respective estates.

9. The Debtors owe me \$0.00 for prepetition services.

10. I agree to be bound by the Order, including the provisions for compensation and expense reimbursement.

11. I am conducting further inquiries regarding my retention by any creditors of the Debtors, and upon conclusion of that inquiry, or at any time during the period of my employment, if I should discover any facts bearing on the matters described herein, I will supplement the information contained in this Affidavit.
