MOTION PURSUANT TO RULE 2090-1(b) OF THE LOCAL RULES OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE, *Pro Hac Vice*

Leslie A. Plaskon (“Movant”), a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of New York, an attorney admitted to practice before the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, and a partner of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP, hereby moves the Court to enter an Order permitting Jesse H. Austin, III, a partner with said firm, to practice *pro hac vice* before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York to represent General Electric Capital Corporation (“GECC”), a party in interest in the above-captioned jointly administered cases, pursuant to Local Rule 2090-1(b) of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. In support of the Motion, Movant states as follows:

1. Jesse H. Austin, III is a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of Georgia, admitted to practice before all state courts in Georgia since 1980. Mr. Austin is

admitted to practice before the United States District Court for the Northern and Middle Districts of Georgia, the Georgia Supreme Court, the Northern District of Texas, and the United States Courts of Appeal for the Fourth, Fifth and Eleventh Circuits. In addition, there are no disciplinary proceedings pending against him as a member of the Georgia Bar.

2. In support of the relief requested in this Motion, attached hereto as Exhibit A is a certificate pursuant to Local Rule 2090-1(b) of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

3. Movant requests that this Court approve this Motion so that Mr. Austin may file pleadings and appear and be heard at hearings in these Chapter 11 cases.

4. Movant agrees to pay the filing fee of \$25 upon approval by the Court admitting Jesse H. Austin, III to practice *pro hac vice*.

WHEREFORE, Movant respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order permitting Jesse H. Austin, III to appear *pro hac vice* for the purpose of representing GECC in the above-captioned jointly administered Chapter 11 cases.

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


