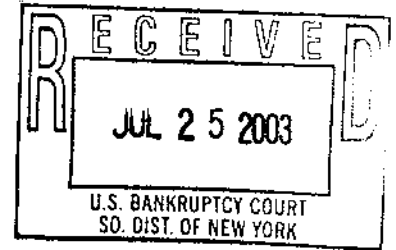

MOTION OF JEFFREY C. ROTH TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

Jeffrey C. Roth, of the firm of Roth & Scholl, pursuant to Local Rules of this Honorable Court, moves for special admission to appear in this case as counsel for Creditor, ACP/WESTSHORE PLACE, LLC and states as follows:

1. Movant is an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Florida and has been a member in good standing of the Florida Bar since 1981.

2. Movant is also admitted to practice before the Bars of the U.S. District Court for the Southern and Middle Districts of Florida, and the Bars of the Fifth and Eleventh U.S. Circuit Courts of Appeals.

3.
