ORDER APPROVING EMPLOYMENT OF TRAXI, LLC

Debtor.

This matter came before the Court pursuant to the Application for Order Approving Employment Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1103 (Traxi, LLC) (the "Application") [Docket No. 336] and the Affidavit of Perry Mandarino, CPA, in Support of Application for Order Under 11 U.S.C. § 1103 and 328(a) and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2014(a) Authorizing and Approving Employment and Retention of Traxi LLC as Financial Advisors for the Official Tort Litigants Committee (the "Mandarino Statement") [Docket No. 338] filed by the Committee for Tort Litigants (the "TLC") on April 12, 2005. On or about April 22 2005, the Catholic Bishop of Spokane (the "Debtor") filed the Debtor's Objection to Application for Order Approving Employment of Traxi, LLC (the "Debtor's Objection") [Docket No. 357]. On or about April 22, 2005, the Committee of Tort Claimants filed the Response of Tort Claimants Committee to Application for Order Approving Employment of Traxi LLC (the "TCC's Comments") [Docket No. 354]. On or about April 28, 2005, the TLC filed the Reply to Debtor's Objection to Application for Order Approving Employment of Traxi, LLC. (the "Reply") [Docket No. 377].

Based upon the Application, the Mandarino Statement, and information contained therein; and the Court having reviewed the TCC's Comments, the Debtor's Objection, which was withdrawn by the Debtor on the record, the Reply and supporting declarations, after hearing thereon, and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- A. The Application is granted, in part, and denied, in part;
- B. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1103(a) and Rule 2014, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the TLC is authorized to employ and retain Traxi LLC as financial advisors as of March 30, 2005;
- C. Traxi may provide limited accounting advice to the TLC so that the TLC understands the overall concept of the Debtor's accounting system, how fund accounting works vis-à-vis the Debtor and the Affiliated Entities (as that term is defined in the Application), to interpret and understand the monthly operating statement, to assist the TLC is formulating questions for depositions, and to analyze what is the financial relationship of the Debtor and the Affiliated Entities.
- D. To the extent that the TLC sought the retention of Traxi to analyze the assets of the Affiliated Entities, the Application is temporarily denied without prejudice to the right of the TLC to renew the Application after the Court's ruling on the TLC's Motion for Summary Judgment set for hearing on June 27, 2005.
- E. Requests for compensation and cost reimbursement from the Debtor's estate shall be subject to approval by Order of the Court.
