SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Honorable Patricia C. Williams on September 26, 2005 for a Scheduling Conference with respect to the Debtor's Motion for Order Fixing New Time for Filing Proofs of Claim, Approving Claim Forms, and Approving Manner and Form of Notice ("Motion"). The Court reviewed the documents herein, heard comments of the parties, and was fully advised in the premises. NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The debtor shall inform the Plaintiffs if they intend to call an expert to present demographic evidence no later than Friday, September 30, 2005.
2. The Future Claims Representative shall file his witness declarations no later than October 5, 2005.

3. The parties shall file and exchange witness lists no later than October 10, 2005, including their designation as experts, the subject matter of their testimony and if the witnesses will be testifying live, by video or by declaration, for their direct testimony.

4. There will be a scheduling conference on October 11, 2005 beginning at 1:30 P.M. at which time the court will consider the proposed witness lists and determine whether the hearing will complete in the scheduled 2 days. If it appears that the testimony may not complete in that time, the court will determine in what manner the witnesses will testify and the time to be allotted to each.

5. The parties shall exchange proposed forms of notice and proofs of claim on or before October 17, 2005.

6. All discovery shall be completed on or before October 31, 2005.

7. The parties shall exchange proposed pretrial orders on or before October 31, 2005, including a list of exhibits.

8. The parties shall file an agreed pretrial order on or before November 7, 2005. If the parties cannot come to an agreement on an agreed pretrial order, each party shall file its proposed pretrial order on or before November 7, 2005.

9. The Court will conduct a pretrial conference on November 10, 2005 at 10:30 ^{A.}~~p.~~m. at which time the Court will enter a final pretrial order.

10. The Debtor shall file its trial brief on or before November 3, 2005. Any party who wishes to file a brief in support of the Debtor's position must do so on or before November 3, 2005. Those parties who oppose the Motion and wish to file a responsive brief must do so on or before November 10, 2005. Reply briefs by the Debtor or parties aligned with the Debtor must be filed on or before November 15, 2005.

11. The Court will conduct an evidentiary hearing on the Motion in Open Court, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on November 17, 2005 and if necessary, will continue at 9:00 a.m. on November 18, 2005.
