15 An order approving the employment of Paine, Hamblen, Coffin, Brooke
16 & Miller LLP as counsel for Debtor was entered by the Court on December
17 23, 2004. Fees and costs incurred during the Application Period have been
18 partially reimbursed as authorized by the Order Granting Motion for Order
19 Establishing Interim Fee Application And Expense Reimbursement Procedure
20 (the "Administrative Order") entered herein on February 2, 2005. Pursuant to
21 the Administrative Order, Paine, Hamblen, Coffin, Brooke & Miller LLP has
22 received \$786,813.00 from Debtor's estate as of October 20, 2005, which has
23 been credited against the fees and costs described in the Second Interim
24 Application.
