**AMENDMENT TO ORDER AUTHORIZING THE
EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF PERELLA WEINBERG
PARTNERS LP AS INVESTMENT BANKER TO THE DEBTORS**

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2013, the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed a petition for relief in this Court under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2013, the Debtors filed an application (the “Application”) for entry of an order, *inter alia*, authorizing the Debtors to employ and retain Perella Weinberg Partners LP (“Perella”) as their investment banker effective *nunc pro tunc* to January 31, 2013, on the terms and conditions set forth in that certain engagement letter between the Debtors and Perella [ECF No. 61]; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2013, the Court held a hearing to consider the relief requested in the Application; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2013, the Court entered an Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Perella Weinberg Partners LP as Investment Banker to the Debtors [ECF No. 84] (the “PWP Retention Order”); and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the entry of the PWP Retention Order, the United States Trustee requested that the PWP Retention Order be amended to clarify the timekeeping requirements for Perella.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The PWP Retention Order is AMENDED to the extent set forth herein.
2. Perella and its professionals (i) shall report time in half hour increments along with reasonably detailed time records and (ii) shall not be required to maintain or provide detailed time records in connection with its fee applications.
3. The PWP Retention Order as modified by this Order shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
4. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
