**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION TO PROOF OF CLAIM NUMBER 175
PURSUANT TO REORGANIZED DEBTORS' SECOND OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO
CERTAIN CLAIMS (CLAIMS THAT CONTRADICT THE DEBTORS' BOOKS
RECORDS, IMPROPERLY CLASSIFIED CLAIMS AND LATE FILED CLAIM)**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. On January 17, 2014, the above debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Reorganized Debtors") filed the Reorganized Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection To Certain Claims (Claims That Contradict The Debtors' Books And Records, Improperly Classified Claims, And Late Filed Claim) (ECF Doc No. 529) (the "Second Claims Objection") with United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the "Bankruptcy Court").

2. On February 7, 2014, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. filed the Response of Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. to Reorganized Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection to Certain Claims (Claims That Contradict The Debtors' Books and Records, Improperly Classified Claims and Late Filed Claim) (ECF Doc No. 546) (the "Wal-Mart Response").

3. On February 10, 2014, the Reorganized Debtors filed the Notice of Adjournment of Reorganized Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection To Certain Claims (ECF Doc No. 547).

4. On February 21, 2014, the Court entered the Order Sustaining The Reorganized Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection To Certain Claims (Claims That Contradict The Debtors' Books And Records, Claims That Are Improperly Classified, And Late Filed Claim), excluding the Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. claim (ECF Doc No. 548).

5. As of the March 11, 2014 Hearing, the Reorganized Debtors and Wal-Mart have since been able to resolve their claim issues, and the Reorganized Debtors hereby withdraw their Second Claims Objection to Claim #175 of Wal-Mart Stores, Inc.
