ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING CLAIMS OBJECTION DEADLINE

Upon the motion [Docket Entry No. 1044] (the “Motion”)¹ of the above-captioned debtor (the “Debtor”) for entry of an order further extending the Claims Objection Deadline, as defined in the First Amended and Restated Joint Chapter 11 Plan filed by the Debtors and the Plan Sponsor dated June 30, 2012, as amended [Docket Entry No. 616, Ex. A] (the “Plan”); the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein; due notice of the Motion and opportunity for hearing having been given to all parties entitled thereto, as listed in the certificate of service attached to the Motion and filed with the Court; a hearing having been held on June 3, 2013 to consider the Motion; no objections to the Motion having been filed or asserted; the Court having determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor’s substantively consolidated bankruptcy estate, its creditors, and all parties in interest; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

¹ Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Motion.

2. The Claims Objection Deadline established by the Plan is hereby extended from June 19, 2013 to December 31, 2013. Subject to further Order of this Court, any objection to any claim of any kind asserted against one or more the debtors² shall be deemed timely filed and served provided that such objection is filed and served by no later than December 31, 2013.

3. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and/or enforcement of this Order.


