**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART THE OBJECTIONS OF VIRGINIA ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY D/B/A DOMINION VIRGINIA POWER AND COLUMBIA GAS OF VIRGINIA, INC. TO THE ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ORDER: (I) DEEMING UTILITIES ADEQUATELY ASSURED OF FUTURE PERFORMANCE; AND (II) ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR DETERMINING REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL ASSURANCE PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY CODE SECTION 366 [DOCKET NO. 54]**

1           At the above-captioned time and place (the "Hearing"), this Court held a hearing on  
2 the *Objection of Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Virginia Power to the*  
3 *Emergency Motion for Order: (I) Deeming Utilities Adequately Assured of Future Performance;*  
4 *and (II) Establishing Procedures for Determining Requests for Additional Assurance Pursuant to*  
5 *Bankruptcy Code Section 366* [Docket No. 72] (the "Dominion Objection"), filed by Virginia  
6 Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Virginia Power ("Dominion"), and the *Objection of*  
7 *Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc. to Debtors' Proposed Adequate Assurance of Payment for Utility*  
8 *Service Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 366(c)(3)* [Docket No. 88] (the "Columbia Objection", and together  
9 with the Dominion Objection, the "Objections"), filed by Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc.  
10 ("Columbia", and together with Dominion, the "Utilities"). Through the Objections, the Utilities  
11 challenged, among other things, (i) the amount and form of "assurance of payment" to which they  
12 are entitled under Bankruptcy Code section 366, and (ii) whether paragraph 2 of the *Order Granting*  
13 *Emergency Motion for Order: (I) Deeming Utilities Adequately Assured of Future Performance; and*  
14 *(II) Establishing Procedures for Determining Requests for Additional Assurance Pursuant to*  
15 *Bankruptcy Code Section 366* [Docket No. 54] (the "Utilities Order") was validly entered under  
16 applicable sections of the Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure  
17 ("Bankruptcy Rules").

18           Upon review and consideration of the Objections, the *Debtors' Omnibus Response to*  
19 *Objections Filed by Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Virginia Power* [Docket  
20 *No. 72]* and *Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc.* [Docket No. 88] *to Amount and Scope of Adequate*  
21 *Assurance That Certain Utilities are Entitled to Under Bankruptcy Code Section 366* [Docket No.  
22 147] (the "Debtors' Response"), filed by Colorep, Inc. and Transprint USA, Inc. (together, the  
23 "Debtors"), all evidence offered in support of the Debtors' Response [Docket Nos. 148–49], the  
24 Utilities' respective replies in support of the Objections and evidence offered in support thereof  
25 [Docket Nos. 154, 156, 159], the record in the above-captioned cases, and the arguments of counsel  
26 at the Hearing, the Court hereby finds, based on its findings of fact and conclusions of law stated on  
27 the record at the Hearing, that the Utilities Order was entered with valid notice to all interested  
28 parties, that Dominion shall be entitled to a deposit of \$32,174.00 as "adequate assurance of

1 payment" under Bankruptcy Code section 366, that Columbia shall be entitled to a deposit of  
2 \$12,000 as "adequate assurance of payment" under Bankruptcy Code section 366, and that the  
3 Utilities Order shall remain valid and in effect except as specifically provided herein.

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND**  
5 **DECREED, AS FOLLOWS:**

- 6 1. The Objections are GRANTED in part, and DENIED in part.
- 7 2. Within 5 days of the entry of this Order, the Debtors shall provide Dominion  
8 with a deposit in the amount of \$32,174.00 as adequate assurance of payment for Dominion's  
9 postpetition services during the Debtors' above-captioned bankruptcy proceedings (the "Dominion  
10 Deposit"). In the event the Debtors fail to timely pay Dominion for Dominion's postpetition services  
11 under applicable nonbankruptcy law, Dominion may setoff against the Dominion Deposit for the  
12 amount of any postpetition arrearage, without first obtaining relief from the automatic stay under  
13 Bankruptcy Code section 362(b).
- 14 3. Within 5 days of the entry of this Order, the Debtors shall provide Columbia  
15 with a deposit in the amount of \$12,000.00 as adequate assurance of payment for Columbia's  
16 postpetition services during the Debtors' above-captioned bankruptcy proceedings (the "Columbia  
17 Deposit"). In the event the Debtors fail to timely pay Columbia for Columbia's postpetition services  
18 under applicable nonbankruptcy law, Columbia may setoff against the Columbia Deposit for the  
19 amount of any postpetition arrearage, without first obtaining relief from the automatic stay under  
20 Bankruptcy Code section 362(b).
- 21 4. The Utilities may be paid by the Debtors, in part, by reducing the amount of  
22 funds placed in an escrow account under paragraph 3 of the Utilities Order, by the amount that was  
23 allocated to the Utilities for their average utility usage.
- 24 5. Paragraph 2 of the Utilities Order shall be modified to read as follows: "The  
25 Debtors' utility service providers (the "Utilities") are prohibited from altering, refusing,  
26 discontinuing service to, or discriminating against the Debtors, without first obtaining an order from  
27 the Court granting relief from the automatic stay under Bankruptcy Code section 362(b)."




