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1                   Upon review and consideration of the *Stipulation Between Debtor and Debtor in*  
2 *Possession and Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc. Regarding Cure Amount for Any Executory Contract*  
3 *Between the Parties* [Docket No. 185] (the "Stipulation")<sup>1</sup> entered into by and among Colorep, Inc.  
4 and Transprint USA, Inc., the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned bankruptcy  
5 proceedings (the "Debtors"), and Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc. ("Columbia"), by and through their  
6 respective counsel of record in these chapter 11 cases, for the purpose of resolving any dispute  
7 regarding the Cure Amount for any executory contract or unexpired lease between the Debtors and  
8 Columbia (the "Contract"), the Court hereby finds that good cause exists to grant the Stipulation, and  
9 hereby orders that:

- 10                   1.       The Stipulation is approved in its entirety.
- 11                   2.       If the Debtors assume, or assume and assign, the Contract, the Cure Amount  
12 for the Contract as of the Petition Date shall be \$48,834.55.
- 13                   3.       Nothing in the Stipulation or in this Order shall: (i) constitute an admission  
14 by either of the Parties as to whether the Contract is an executory contract or unexpired lease;  
15 (ii) prejudice Columbia's right to challenge the assumption, or assumption and assignment, of the  
16 Contract by the Debtors; or (iii) affect or alter the Debtors' right to challenge the amount, validity, or  
17 priority of any claim(s) asserted by Columbia against the Debtors' estates if the Contract is not  
18 assumed, or assumed and assigned, by the Debtors.
- 19                   4.       The Bankruptcy Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the  
20 Stipulation.
