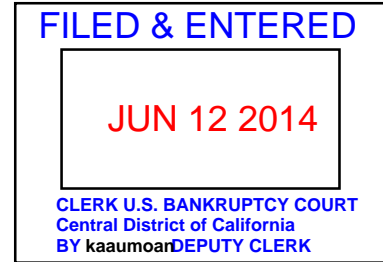

25 record.


26 Based upon the pleadings, the record in this case and the statements and arguments of counsel
27 at the time of hearing, and good cause appearing, it is hereby
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ORDERED, that the Debtors' Motion shall be and is hereby granted, and it is further
ORDERED, that the Chapter 11 cases shall be dismissed; provided, however,
1. This Order shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any Bankruptcy Court order
entered during the course of this case, and
2. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over all of the following matters:
a. Overseeing any administrative matter that may arise in connection with implementing
the requested dismissal;
b. Approving fees of any professionals whose fees are subject to court approval;
c. Resolving any disputes, claims or causes of action that may arise in connection with
the APA; and
d. Entering orders as may be necessary to implement the requested dismissal.
