**AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF COUNSEL REGARDING ORDER
SUSTAINING LIQUIDATING TRUSTEE’S SECOND OMNIBUS
(SUBSTANTIVE) OBJECTION TO CERTAIN NO LIABILITY CLAIMS**

The undersigned certifies as follows:

1. On October 16, 2013, the Trustee (the “Liquidating Trustee”) of the Conexant Liquidating Trust, by and through its undersigned counsel, filed the Liquidating Trustee’s Second Omnibus (Substantive) Objection to Certain No Liability Claims (Docket No. 383) (the “Second Omnibus Objection”).
2. Any objections to the Second Omnibus Objection were to be filed and served no later than November 8, 2013, at 4:00 p.m. (Eastern).
3. On October 31, 2013, Meyer Properties (“Meyer”) filed a response to the Second Omnibus Objection (Docket No. 402) (the “Response”). Counsel for the Liquidating Trustee and Meyer have resolved the Response. Meyer consents that Claim No. 49 is hereby reduced and allowed in the amount of \$13,219.64.
4. As of the date hereof, the undersigned has received no other answer, objection, or any other responsive pleading to the Second Omnibus Objection,

and no other answer, objection, or other responsive pleading appears on the docket of the above-captioned jointly administered bankruptcy cases.

5. On November 13, 2013, the Liquidating Trustee filed the Certification of Counsel Regarding Order Sustaining Liquidating Trustee's Second Omnibus (Substantive) Objection to Certain No Liability Claims (Docket No. 405).

6. Thereafter, on November 15, 2013, the Court held a hearing on the Second Omnibus Objection (the "Hearing"). At the Hearing, the Court raised inquiries regarding Claim Nos. 78 and 79 filed by Xin Fan and requested that those claims be continued until January 9, 2014 at 11:30 a.m. (Eastern) at which time the Court will hold an evidentiary hearing with respect to those two claims.

7. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is the revised, proposed form of Order Sustaining Liquidating Trustee's Second Omnibus (Substantive) Objection to Certain No Liability Claims (the "Proposed Order"). Attached hereto as Exhibit 2 is a blackline that compares the form of order filed with the Second Omnibus Objection to the Proposed Order, reflecting the Court's ruling at the Hearing and the resolution of Claim No. 49 between Meyer and the Liquidating Trustee.

8. The undersigned respectfully submits that the Court may consider and enter the Proposed Order at the Court's earliest convenience, without further notice or hearing.
