Dear Mr. Hoke:

The Court acknowledges receipt of your Petition for Stay dated February 14, 2014 and the Objection to Declaration of Readiness dated September 8, 2014.

Petitions for Stay are not normally handled by a line judge. Frankly, however, it is unclear to the undersigned as to why, if Conexant was self-insured on the dates of Applicant's 1995 and 1996 injuries, that the Self-Insurers' Security Fund has never been joined, in the very same fashion as CIGA was joined for the other employer in this case, Kimco, whose carrier is also bankrupt.

CIGA and SISF would then be on the same footing, since neither represents "other coverage" and once they litigate the issue of General/ Special employment (if that is a disputed issue), the case can proceed normally.

Never having seen this scenario, you may know reasons why this cannot be done. Regardless, the Conference shall remain on Calendar for December 2nd at which all can be further explored or, alternatively, the issues can be set for Trial.


