**SECOND INTERIM AND FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF SAK MANAGEMENT SERVICES, LLC FOR COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES AS MEDICAL OPERATIONS ADVISOR TO THE PATIENT CARE OMBUDSMAN FOR (I) THE SECOND INTERIM PERIOD OF MARCH 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 6, 2019, AND (II) THE FINAL PERIOD OF SEPTEMBER 18, 2018 THROUGH JUNE 6, 2019**

SAK Management Services, LLC (“SAK”), as medical operations advisor to Suzanne Koenig, the Patient Care Ombudsman (the “**Ombudsman**”), hereby submits its final fee application (the “**Application**”) and seeks entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the “**Proposed Order**”), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331, granting: (i) approval and allowance of its compensation and reimbursement of fees in the amount of \$15,385.00 and expenses in the amount of \$2,076.93 for the period of March 1, 2019 through June 6, 2019 (the “**Second Interim Period**”), and (ii) final approval and allowance of its compensation and reimbursement of fees in the amount of \$74,070.00 and expenses in the amount of \$12,305.69 for the period of September 18, 2018 through June 6, 2019 (the “**Final Period**”), and (iii) authorizing and directing the Liquidating Trustee to pay to SAK all such outstanding amounts requested in this Application. In support of this Application, SAK respectfully represents as follows:

## GENERAL BACKGROUND

1. On August 24, 2018 (the “**Petition Date**”), the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with this Court commencing the Chapter 11 Cases. The factual background regarding the Debtors, including their business operations, debt structure, and the events leading to the filing of the Chapter 11 Cases is set forth in detail in the *Declaration of Stephen N. Clapp, Chief Executive Officer of Curae Health, Inc., in Support of Chapter 11 Petitions and First Day Pleadings* [Docket No. 49].

2. On August 29, 2018, the Court entered an order authorizing the joint administration of the Chapter 11 Cases [Docket No. 59].

3. On September 18, 2018, the Office of the United States Trustee appointed the Ombudsman [Docket No. 191].

4. On November 1, 2018, the Court entered an *Order Authorizing the Retention and Employment of SAK Management Services, LLC, as Medical Operations Advisor, Nunc Pro Tunc as of September 18, 2018* [Docket No. 387].

5. On February 26, 2019, SAK filed its *First Interim Fee Application of SAK Management Services, LLC for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses as Medical Operations Advisor to the Patient Care Ombudsman for the Period from September 18, 2018 through January 31, 2019* [Docket No. 812]. On April 1, 2019, the court entered the *Order Granting First Interim Fee Application of SAK Management Services, LLC as Medical Operations Advisor to the Patient Care Ombudsman* [Docket No. 917]. SAK was awarded \$68,913.76 (\$58,685.00 for fees and \$10,228.76 for expenses).

6. On March 4, 2019, the Debtors and the Committee filed a Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Liquidation [Docket No. 834] (the “**Plan**”), which was confirmed by Order of this Court.

7. On June 11, 2019, the Debtors and the Committee declared the effective date of the Plan, pursuant to which a liquidating trust was established (the “**Liquidating Trust**”) and Stephen D. Sass, LLC was appointed as the liquidating trustee (the “**Liquidating Trustee**”).

8. This is the second interim and final fee application for fees and expenses incurred by SAK as medical services advisor to the Ombudsman in the Chapter 11 Cases.

### **PROJECT CATEGORIES**

9. Attached hereto as **Exhibit B** are detailed statement of services rendered in the aggregate amount of \$15,385.00 and expenses incurred in the amount of \$2,076.93 during the Compensation Period. The services have been put in the following categories:

### **STATEMENT OF APPLICANT**

10. The services were actual and necessary services rendered by SAK as medical operations advisor to the Ombudsman and the compensation requested is reasonable. Although this Application is not governed by the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013* (the “**UST Guidelines**”), SAK prepared the attached exhibits in the interest of transparency: Summary Cover Sheet as **Exhibit C**; Summary of Timekeepers as **Exhibit D**. These Exhibits provide a summary of the fee application and the rates being charged by SAK in this Application.

11. In accordance with the foregoing, SAK states that no professionals from SAK covered by this Application have varied their hourly rates based upon the geographical location of the Chapter 11 cases.

**EXPENSES**

12. This Application includes a request for reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$2,076.93 which are expenses incurred by SAK, further described below. All expenses were actual and necessary expenses incurred in providing the services described herein and are reimbursable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 330.

13. SAK further requests reimbursement of expenses incurred during the Final Period in the amount of \$12,305.69 (which represents the sum of expenses incurred during the Second Interim Period (\$2,076.93) and expenses incurred during the First Interim Period (\$10,228.76)).

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 330, SAK seeks entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto, providing that: (a) an allowance be made to SAK for the Second Interim Period in the amount of (i) \$15,385.00 as compensation for necessary professional services rendered, and (ii) \$2,076.93 for actual and necessary expenses incurred, for a total of \$17,461.93; (b) a final allowance to be made to SAK for the Final Period in the amount of (i) \$74,070.00 as compensation for necessary professional services renders, and (ii) \$12,305.69 for actual and necessary expenses incurred, for a total of \$86,375.69; (c) that the Liquidating Trustee is authorized and directed to pay SAK all outstanding amount of such sums; and (d) for such other and further relief as is just and proper.

**PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING SECOND INTERIM AND FINAL FEE  
APPLICATION OF SAK MANAGEMENT SERVICES, LLC FOR COMPENSATION  
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES AS MEDICAL OPERATIONS ADVISOR TO

Upon consideration of the Application of SAK Management Services, LLC as medical operations advisor to the Patient Care Ombudsman (the “**Ombudsman**”), for allowance of compensation and reimbursement of expenses; and it appearing to the Court that all of the requirements of sections 327, 328, 330, 331 and 503(b) of title 11 of the United States Code, as well as Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Rules 2016-1 and 9013-1 of the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Tennessee, have been satisfied; and it further appearing that the expenses incurred were reasonable and necessary; and that notices of the Application was appropriate; and after due deliberation and sufficient good cause appearing; and that there were no objections to the Application, it is hereby

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

1. The Application of SAK is approved on a final basis.
2. The fees in the amount of \$15,385.00 and expenses in the amount of \$2,076.93 incurred by SAK during the Compensation Period are hereby allowed as being reasonable compensation and actual, necessary services and expenses of the estates and thus payable as fees and expenses pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 330.

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3. The final fees in the amount of \$74,070.00 and final expenses in the amount of \$12,305.69 incurred by SAK during the Final Period are hereby allowed as being reasonable compensation and actual, necessary services and expenses of the estates and thus payable as fees and expenses pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 503(b)(2).

4. The Liquidated Trustee is authorized and directed, as provided herein, to remit, or cause to be remitted, payment of all outstanding fees and expenses to SAK. Payment of such amounts shall be first paid from the Professional Fee Escrow up to the Budgeted Amount. Any remaining unpaid amounts shall then be paid from the Liquidating Trust.

5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
