AGREED ORDER ESTABLISHING A DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF CONTRACT-REJECTION DAMAGE CLAIMS ASSERTED BY THE MEDHOST ENTITIES

This matter is presently before the Court on the Joint Motion of Steven D Sass LLC, the duly-appointed Liquidating Trustee under the confirmed Joint Plan of Liquidation, and certain MedHost Entities (as defined in the Joint Motion), to establish a deadline for the MedHost Entities to file contract-rejection damage claims by virtue of the Debtor Curae Health, Inc.’s rejection of certain MedHost Agreements (as defined in the Joint Motion).

It appears to the Court, and as represented by the Liquidating Trustee and the MedHost Entities, that it is appropriate for the MedHost Entities to be given a deadline for filing contract-rejection damage claims. As evidenced by the signatures of counsel for the Liquidating Trustee and the MedHost Entities below, the parties have agreed that the MedHost Entities should have

up to and including thirty (30) days to file with the Court claims arising from the rejection of the MedHost Agreements.

There being no further notice required, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Joint Motion is approved; and
2. The MedHost Entities shall have up to and including thirty (30) days from the entry of this Agreed Order within which to file with the Court any claims asserted under 11 U.S.C. § 502(g) for the rejection of the MedHost Agreements. All rights of the parties with respect to such claims are hereby expressly reserved.
