AGREED ORDER CONTINUING HEARING ON MOTION OF DEBTORS FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING ASSUMPTION OF PHYSICIAN CONTRACTS AND PAYMENT OF PROPOSED CURE AMOUNTS

This matter is before the Court on the above-captioned Chapter 11 debtors (“**Debtors**”) expedited motion for entry of an order setting an expedited hearing (the “**Expedited Motion**”) [Docket No. 108] on the *Expedited Motion of Debtors for Entry of an Order Authorizing Assumption of Physician Contracts and Payment of Proposed Cure Amounts* (“**Motion to Assume Contracts**”) [Docket No. 106] and the Court’s entry of the order setting a hearing for September 11, 2018 [Docket No. 110] as requested by Debtors.

The United States Trustee formed an official committee of unsecured creditors (the “**Committee**”) on September 6, 2018 [Docket No. 112]. The Committee will seek retention of Sills Cummis & Gross P.C. and Manier & Herod as co-counsel to the Committee.

Although Debtors seek the relief requested in Debtors’ Motion to Assume Contracts on an emergency basis and maintain that the circumstances described in the Motion to Assume Contracts on which the emergency request is based are continuing, due to: (a) the recent appointment of the Committee and the Committee’s request for sufficient time to review

Debtors' Motion to Assume and related documents; and (b) observance of the Jewish holiday Rosh Hashanah, which falls on September 11, 2018, Debtors, the Committee, and the U.S. Trustee, by and through their undersigned counsel, have agreed to a one-week continuance of Debtors' Motion to Assume Contracts.

Pursuant to the agreement of undersigned counsel, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that cause exists, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The hearing on Debtors' Motion to Assume Contracts is continued as provided herein.

2. The Court will hold a hearing on the *Expedited Motion of Debtors for Entry of an Order Authorizing Assumption of Physician Contracts and Payment of Proposed Cure Amounts* on **September 18, 2018, commencing at 9:00 a.m.**, Courtroom 2, 701 Broadway, Nashville, TN.

3. Debtors shall serve a copy of this Order in the manner set forth in paragraph 3 of the Expedited Motion.
