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**AGREED ORDER EXTENDING RESPONSE DEADLINES FOR OFFICIAL  
COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF CURAE HEALTH, INC., ET AL.**

This matter is before the Court on: the (a) Expedited Motion of Debtors for an Order Authorizing: (I) Continued Use of Existing Cash Management System, including Maintenance of Existing Bank Accounts, Checks, and Business Forms; (II) Suspension of Certain U.S. Trustee

Bank Account Requirements; and (III) Continuation of Existing Deposit Practices (the “Cash Management Motion”) [Dkt Entry No. 7]; (b) the Expedited Interim Order Authorizing: (I) Continued Use of Existing Cash Management System, including Maintenance of Existing Bank Accounts, Checks, and Business Forms; (II) Suspension of Certain U.S. Trustee Bank Account Requirements; and (III) Continuation of Existing Deposit Practices (the “Interim Cash Management Order”) [Dkt Entry No. 65]; and (c) the Debtors’ Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Authorizing and Approving Bidding Procedures for the Sale of Gilmore Medical Center, (II) Authorizing Sale of Gilmore Medical Center Free and Clear of All Liens, Claims, Encumbrances, and Other Interests, (III) Approving Stalking Horse Purchaser, Break-Up Fee and Overbid Protections, (IV) Establishing Certain Procedures for the Assumption and Assignment of Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases, (V) Scheduling an Auction, (VI) Scheduling a Hearing and Objection Deadlines with Respect to the Sale of Gilmore Medical Center, (VII) Approving the Form and Manner of Notice thereof, and (VIII) Granting Related Relief (the “Gilmore Sales Procedures Motion”) [Dkt Entry No. 79]. The Interim Cash Management Order set the objection deadline for the Cash Management Motion as September 18, 2018. The Notice of Hearing for the Gilmore Sale Procedures Motion set the objection deadline for the Gilmore Sale Procedures Motion as September 18, 2018.

The above-captioned Chapter 11 Debtors (the “Debtors”) and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Curae Health, Inc., *et al.* (the “Committee”), each by and through their undersigned counsel, have agreed to the extension of the objection deadlines for the Cash Management Motion and Gilmore Sales Procedures Motion from September 18, 2018, to September 21, 2018, it is therefore:

ORDERED that the objection deadlines for the Committee to object or respond to the Cash Management Motion and Gilmore Sales Procedures Motion are both extended from September 18, 2018, to September 21, 2018; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order only extends the objection deadlines for the Committee to the Cash Management Motion and Gilmore Sales Procedures Motion and does not extend such objection deadlines for any other party.
