AGREED ORDER REGARDING CURE AMOUNTS

Before this Court is the objection filed by Beckman Coulter, Inc. (“Beckman Coulter”) [Docket No. 407] (hereinafter, the “Objection”) with respect to the Notice of [I] Debtors’ Intent to Assume and Assign Certain Executory Contracts, Unexpired Leases of Personal Property, and Unexpired Leases of Nonresidential Real Property and (II) Cure Amounts Related to the Foregoing [Docket No. 371]. Based upon the signatures of counsel below, the Objection has been resolved pursuant to a stipulation by and among the Debtors, North Mississippi Health Services, Inc., and Beckman Coulter, based upon an agreement as to the terms and amounts for curing Beckman Coulter’s respective agreements with one or more of the Debtors, and the Court finding good cause therefor it is hereby ORDERED:
