On November 19, 2004, The DCHC Liquidating Trust (the "Trust") filed a motion (the "Motion") to file a certain complaint (the "Complaint") under seal. The Court granted the Motion (in part) on November 19, 2004 through the issuance of an interim order (the "Interim Order"). In the Interim Order, the Court indicated that it was granting the relief requested on an interim basis so that it could examine the merits of the Motion more closely. The Court also indicated that the Trust could file a supplemental memorandum in support of the Motion. The

Trust filed its supplemental memorandum (the "Supplemental Memorandum") on November 24,
